



## Need help buying food? Pandemic EBT (P-EBT) funds are coming

Money for food is coming to families with kids who receive free or reduced-price school meals.

**The public charge rule does NOT apply to P-EBT benefits.**

Watch your mail for a P-EBT card or look for the funds to be added to the Ohio Direction Card you already have. Keep your P-EBT card - funds may be added at a later date.

Families will receive one card per eligible child. Any child in grades K-12 that receive free or reduced-price school meals will receive a card.

P-EBT funds can be spent at stores, shops, or farmers markets that sell groceries. You can buy foods like fruits and vegetables, dry goods, meat, dairy, and eggs. P-EBT funds are NOT SNAP and do NOT impact your or your children's immigration status.
