



Attention Retailers: Look out for a new way to pay!

Beginning in May, our store will accept Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer cards, or P-EBT cards. These are part of a new program to help families with students in grades K-12 afford food because of the COVID-19 school closures.

THINGS TO KNOW:

1. P-EBT cards look different than the Ohio Direction Card, but are used in the same way.
2. P-EBT cards can be used to buy the same food items that can be bought with a SNAP EBT card.
3. P-EBT cards are issued to each eligible child in the home. Families may use multiple cards in one visit.
4. P-EBT cards are in the name of the child. Just as with a SNAP EBT card, retailers should not inspect the card. All household members and additional authorized persons are allowed to use the card.
5. Customers paying with P-EBT must create a PIN for their card. They should follow the instructions that came with the card to create a four-digit PIN.
6. Are customers having difficulty using their P-EBT card? Tell them to call the number on the back of their card for help or to check their balance.
